### God the Father

1. How many Gods (true God – not idol gods) are there? See what Isaiah 43:10 says: “Ye [are] my witnesses, saith the Lord, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and \_\_\_\_\_ me, and understand that I [am] He: before Me there was \_\_\_\_\_ God formed, neither shall there be \_\_\_\_\_ Me.
